### **Advocacy Committee Changes**

Change 1. Remove to Part III (General By-Laws Code), Article II (Branch Bylaws), Section A (Advocacy Committee), 5. Powers, Duties, & Responsibilities

- a. Shall meet at least once a week during the Spring and Fall semesters to address issues related to students and colleges.
- b. Shall examine local, state and federal legislation; ballot initiatives; and policies.
- c. Shall examine campus and Coast Community College District policies.
- d. Shall organize and execute legislative visits at least once a year.
- e. Shall address issues related to state and regional shared governance.
- f. Shall conduct a polling event once a semester to get a better understanding of the concerns of Orange Coast College students.
- g. Shall communicate its findings to the Student Senate and Executive Board through the Vice President of Advocacy Committee.
